- Kids want to join C-C to participate in the singing.

- Rhonda copied a "Good Question" article from the Sept/Oct issue of Children's Ministry to give to the Sunday School teachers. This article emphasized the importance of asking questions that prompt the children to think more deeply about their faith.
- S.S. Attendance awards for the 4th Quarter (March, April, May) will be awarded in the 10:45 service on June. 8. (Think I will do ice cream cones from Miller Drug). We will also do promotion certificates that Sunday and recognize SS Teachers for the summer.

## K-5 Alive

Rhonda gave the K-5 Alive kids and helpers a survey to complete on the last day of K-5 Alive. Here are some notes from what she gained from their comments.

- We need more time for Bible Verse memorization. Maybe if we pulled some of the activities from the Bible Study curriculum and did that during the game time, it would free up some time to focus on the scripture.
- Move games to the end of the program for only 10 minutes. Having games at the end, might also entice some of the kids to stay on task during the Bible study time.
- Reciting last week's verse during snack time each week would help them remember the verses more.
- Give incentives for Bible Verse memorization.
- Need to research games or activities that would aid in scripture memorization.
- The small groups are well-liked, especially when I send groups to different rooms. The kids are able to focus better in that separated quiet atmosphere.
- We might try pulling non-readers into separate rooms with helpers during the small group time, and letting the 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Graders remain in the K-5 Alive Room so they can read the scriptures to themselves. A couple kids said they would prefer to read themselves, rather than having someone read to them. Many kids are able to respond more in discussion when they actually are reading the material themselves.
- Eliminate some of the question time from the curriculum so that the Bible Study is no more than 20 minutes long. (30- to 40- minutes is too long after being in school all day.)

Rhonda needs to search for homemade hand-cream or hand cleaner recipe that Stephanie mentioned previously to consider using that as a craft idea for the mission team's bazaar.

Judy Headley and Karen Shearer have committed to serving in K-5 Alive for the 2014-2015 school year.

Rhonda will be looking for 3 youth helpers for next year.
