

## GLENN AND GLADYS EVANS ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

This endowment scholarship for higher education is renewable for four consecutive years or eight semesters. To allow us to provide this scholarship to more students, this scholarship is limited to those attending trade school, technical school, associate or bachelor degree programs and those continuing on into United Methodist seminary school.

1. Who is eligible:
  - Any student who has graduated from high school or received an equivalent diploma such as the GED and who is a member of Macon United Methodist Church.
  - A Letter is sent to all high school students advising the availability of scholarship. The Youth Director's responsibility to see it goes out.
  - Exceptions will be considered.
2. How to apply:
  - The student will pick up an application from the church's business office or download from church's website.
3. Criteria:
  - Each candidate will be considered by the Scholarship Team on an individual basis.
  - Special focus will be given to attendance and participation of the applicant in the current life of the Macon United Methodist Church, especially participation in the youth programs (including youth group activities and Sunday school).
  - Good citizenship and character are vital.
4. The Scholarship Team (selective committee) consists of:
  - The Pastor
  - Chairperson of the Administrative Council
  - Chairperson of the United Methodist Men
  - Church Treasurer
  - Director of Youth Ministry
  - Director of Children's Ministry
  - And one person chosen by the Pastor

If any of the above appointed team members has a family member who is being considered for a scholarship, that person will recuse himself/herself from that portion of the meeting.

5. Payment and renewability:
  - One-half of the scholarship amount for that year will be paid per semester.
  - Proof of enrollment is required.
  - Renewal scholarships will be paid upon proof of enrollment of at least 12 hours and proof of at least a 2.0 average.
  - Exceptions will be considered.

6. Recipients will receive a certificate and payment will follow pending notification of enrollment.
7. All scholarships are subject to the Endowment's ability to earn and support them.
